

We are looking for the donation of a piece of chalkboard to replace the one we have in the Butterfly Garden, which has weathered. Approximate size 24" x 20". Thank you.

We are still looking for someone to paint the peak on the Westside Bathrooms. We will provide the supplies, scaffolding and ladders. We will be there with you to keep you safe while you are 10' off the ground.

We have been working on clearing and cleaning out from behind the tractor garage. We found 2-or 3-year old full leaf bags that had many catalpa pods and orange plastic fencing, a 4' x 10' countertop, a large dresser/sidebar, large quantity of chicken wire, roofing shingles, futon mattress and frame, plus much more.

Please consider when placing these items in this area, you need to come back and set them out for Wixom's garbage day, either Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning.

We were hoping that by providing the dumpsters in the spring we would give the members a chance to clean camps inside and out, which would eliminate the need for members to toss furniture behind the dumpsters at the clubroom and behind the tractor garage.

Please remember that we are a co-operative. No one should have to clean up after another member. Sorry to be a crabapple about this topic, but it has been a problem for over 20 plus years. In the future, please feel free to contact me, to help you figure out what to do with your large or questionable items. We all would appreciate your thoughtfulness and cooperation in this.

Trash Rules: Dumpsters are for members use only! Do not put in large or long items that may wedge or jam the dumpster when being tipped into the garbage truck. No major dumping on festival weekends. No overfilling. No furniture, propane tanks, wood, construction materials or other large items are to be left in, by or around the dumpster. Large items can be placed at roadside near the tractor garage on Tuesdays for Wednesday pickup. The dumpster at Sun Lake is for Finn Camp projects only. No personal or camp debris is allowed.

Facility Reservations: Any member interested in renting the clubroom, dancehall, ravintola, or

beach should contact the social director, Joni Sennhenn, at 248-882-4626. Also, all committees should verify venue availability with the social director prior to scheduling events as private rentals may conflict.



Finland shuts borders with Russia

The move comes as thousands of Russian men have reportedly begun fleeing the country following Russian President Putin's decree this week calling for a "partial mobilization" to funnel more men into the war in Ukraine. Some 300,000 men are expected to be mobilized to fight in Ukraine, where Russian troops have allegedly seen significant losses
